In compliance with the California Supreme Court's decision in *Jameson v. Desta*, a party with a fee waiver may request an official court reporter for trial in an unlimited jurisdiction civil, probate or family law case or for a civil law and motion hearing, notwithstanding the limitations set out in Ventura County Superior Court Local Rule 18.00.D. To request a court reporter, the party with a fee waiver must make the request in writing, in a separate pleading and file it with the clerk at least ten (10) days before the date of the trial or hearing. The court presiding over a particular trial or hearing, for good cause, may shorten or waive the ten (10) days requirement.

The court shall continue to automatically provide court reporters to all parties in the proceedings set out in Ventura County Superior Court Local Rule 18.00.D.

This order shall automatically expire on January 2, 2019, unless extended by the court.
