11:29 a.m. Court reconvenes with plaintiff(s), defendant(s) and counsel present as noted above and all prospective jurors present.

Plaintiff's voir dire continues.

12:01 p.m. Prospective jurors are admonished and excused for lunch and court is in recess.

1:32 p.m. Court is in session, out of the presence of the jury, with plaintiff(s), defendant(s) and counsel present as noted above. The Court and counsel discuss Parties state that case has settled..

Court's Order to Show Cause Re: Dismissal Pursuant to Representation of Settlement is scheduled for 04/07/2016 at 08:30 AM in Department 43.

The Court orders no appearance is necessary if Notice of Settlement is/are filed 1 calendar days prior to the hearing.

1:38 p.m. Court reconvenes with plaintiff(s), defendant(s) and counsel present as noted above and all prospective jurors present.

The Court informs the prospective jurors that the case has resolved.

The remaining prospective jurors are thanked and excused and directed to return to Jury Commissioner's office.

After prospective jurors have exited the courtroom:
