APPEARING REMOTELY BY ZOOM IN COURTROOM 20 MATTERS
Pursuant to CCP §§128 and 367.75, and the Administrative Orders of the Presiding Judge, and until further notice, all attorneys, self-represented parties, and witnesses who appear for a proceeding calendared in Courtroom 20 may appear remotely by Zoom.

Unless otherwise authorized by the Court, Zoom appearances will not be permitted on the following type of matters:
Jury Trials, Small Claims Appeals, ORAPS

- After being checked in, you will be placed in the waiting room until your case is called. (Please mute your audio while you wait.)

DO NOT GIVE OUT THE ZOOM ADDRESS TO ANYONE.

Only the attorney, parties, and witnesses of the case will be allowed into the Zoom meeting.

All those appearing by Zoom shall comply with the following orders:

- (1) Participants shall be dressed in business-like, not casual, attire appropriate to the formality of the courtroom;
- (2) Participants may not use background features available on the Zoom app;
- (3) Participants shall be in a private, quiet location devoid of distractions;
- (4) Participants shall not be driving an automobile or engaged in any activity which distracts from the ability to focus on the court proceedings.
- (5) Participants shall not use any filters or graphics which modify or alter the video image or voices of participants;
- (6) At all times, participants shall behave in a manner consistent with proper courtroom decorum; and
- (7) Participants must arrange for reliable internet access which ensures, to the extent possible, uninterrupted audio and video connection.

YOU MAY NOT RECORD ANY COURT PROCEEDING

Any recording of the court proceeding held by video or teleconference, including screen shots or any other form of audio or visual recording is strictly prohibited.
