## JUVENILE COURT

- 1. This order applies to all cases heard in courtroom J1 located at the Juvenile Courthouse, 4353 E. Vineyard Avenue, Oxnard.
- 2. This order takes effect on June 28, 2021.
- 3. This order supersedes Administrative Order No. 20.44.
- 4. Any person authorized to be present in the courtroom shall abide by Amended Administrative
  Order 21.08
- 5. Dependency Cases (case numbers starting with the letter "J"):
  - Un-contested hearings:
    - o Attorneys and their clients may be present in court or appear via Zoom.
    - o Non-parties (e.g., relatives, caregivers, Court Appointed Special Advocates) shall continue to appear via Zoom.
  - Trials/contested evidentiary hearings:
    - o All parties, their attorneys, and witnesses shall be present in court unless permission to appear via Zoom is granted by the judge before the hearing.
- 6. Probate Guardianship of Minors (case numbers starting with the number "56"):
  - <u>Un-contested hearings</u>:
    - o The following persons may be present in court or appear via Zoom:
      - Petitioners
      - Guardians

- Parent of the subject minor child
- Minor child subject to the petition/guardianship
- Attorneys for the above persons
- o All other persons and the public may appear via Zoom

## Trials/contested evidentiary hearings:

- o All parties, their attorneys, and witnesses shall be present in court unless permission to appear via Zoom is granted by the judge before the hearing.
- o All other persons and the public, if the hearing is not closed, may appear via Zoom

## 7. Termination of Parental Rights Cases (case numbers starting with the letter "T"):

- Un-contested hearings:
  - o The following persons may come to court or appear via Zoom:
    - Petitioners
    - Parent of the subject minor child
    - Minor child subject to the petition
    - Attorneys for the above persons
- Trials/contested evidentiary hearings:
  - All parties, their attorneys, and witnesses shall be present in court unless
     permission to appear via Zoom is granted by the judge before the hearing.
- 8. Adoption Finalization Cases (case numbers starting with the letter "A"):
  - Parties, their attorneys, social workers and guests may come to court or appear via
     Zoom. No more than 10 persons (not including court staff) shall be allowed into
     courtroom J1 at the same time.
