FORMAL INSTALLATION CEREMONY FOR JUDGE FERDINAND P. INUMERABLE

The formal installation ceremony for Judge Ferdinand “Dino” Inumerable will take place on Friday, April 18, 2014, at 4:00 p.m. in Courtroom 22 of the Hall of Justice in Ventura. The oath of office will be administered by Judge Bruce Young.

The ceremony will be open to the public, elected officials, local bar, and representatives of court-related county departments. The press is invited to attend and to take any desired photographs during these special ceremonial proceedings.

Judge Inumerable was appointed to the bench by Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr., on January 28, 2014. He fills the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Ellen Gay Conroy in November 2013.

Judge Inumerable served as a commissioner with the Ventura County Superior Court since May 2010. Prior to that, he was a senior deputy public defender with the Ventura County Public Defender’s Office from 2000 to 2010 and a deputy public defender at the Santa Barbara County Public Defender’s Office from 1995 to 1999. He was an attorney at the Law Offices of Bill Hom from 1994 to 1995.

Judge Inumerable is a graduate of the University of Michigan and Thomas Jefferson School of Law in San Diego. He is currently assigned to Courtroom 48, hearing felony and misdemeanor criminal trials, unlawful detainers and small claims.
