The Court allows Zoom appearances as a courtesy, and may require in-person appearances in accordance with [CCP 367.75\(b\)](#) and [CRC 3.672\(d\)](#).

- RENAME YOUR Device by your name & title (e.g., Jane Doe, Counsel for Plaintiff OR John Doe, Plaintiff) NOT Jane’s iphone or Samsung 3512.
- You may have to wait several minutes prior to being checked in by the judicial assistant.
- MUTE yourself once admitted to Courtroom 21 until your case is called.

AT THE HEARING:

- Conduct yourself as though appearing in court in person, to include court-appropriate demeanor, dress, and conduct. The Court will require you to turn your camera on during your appearance.
- Ensure sufficient technical capability and reliable internet connection to appear remotely.
- Eliminate background noise and distractions.
- YOU MAY NOT record any part of the proceedings, to include screen shots or any other form of audio or visual recording. ([CRC 1.150](#) & [Penal Code § 632](#))
